**Why not make a weekend of it?:** Most NAS ELearning Fieldschools are run over a weekend with the Introduction ELearning Fieldschool run on the Saturday and the Part 1 ELearning Fieldschool being run on the Sunday. You are welcome to attend each fieldschool day at a different date, or why not save travel costs and make a weekend of it and attend both the Introduction and the Part 1 at the same time?

Elearners will be given the chance to use the data collected to start their NAS Part 2 reports. Information obtained during NAS ELearning Fieldschools will be used to build up data sets that can be added to the Historic Environment Records every year.

### **Who teaches the NAS ELearning Fieldschools?**

NAS ELearning Fieldschools are taught by experienced NAS Tutors. In some cases NAS Tutors will be working with the help of our training partners and supporters such as Promare in the SW; the Thames Discovery Programme in London; the Malvern Archaeological Diving Unit in Wales, and the SCAPE Trust in Scotland. All our diving operations are managed by competent registered NAS Diving Supervisors who will have experience of managing diving operations on archaeological sites.

### **Not an NAS ELearner, but still interested in joining an NAS ELearning Fieldschool?**

Spaces on ELearning Fieldschools will first be offered to ELearners so that they can fulfil the taught practical elements of the Introduction and Part 1 courses. Should places still be available on a Fieldschool the NAS will offer those places to NAS members and trainees. Attendance could be used to obtain survey data for your Part 2 project report, as fieldwork days towards your NAS Part 4, or simply just for fun. Contact the NAS office to book a place.
